Where, When, and What to Expect

Are you thinking about publishing in an academic journal or have you recently submitted your work for peer review? Are you wondering where you should aim your research? Are you getting direction or do you need to decide where to publish yourself? How will you choose after you graduate? Maybe you feel anxious as you ponder your progress in comparison with your peers? This workshop discusses several variables that you may want to consider before and after you submit your research to a journal. It will cover journals types, journal rankings, publications fees, review time, how to deal with rejection, and how to deal with and use reviewer comments. Publishing in academia is not supposed to be easy, so do not easily give up on your ideas.
