

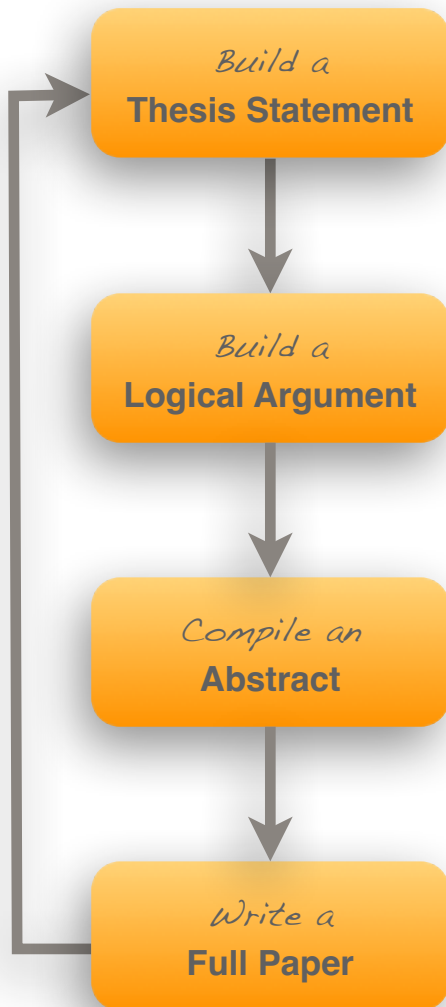

Research Skills T: Logical Thinking Skills in the Age of AI - II (Eng)
